Sudhir's Academic History

Nursery to 5th class: Bhadrachalam Public School and Junior college.

Then wrote an entrance test, for Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas present nationwide, conducted by the Central government in which he was qualified and was among the 80 students selected from the same district.

6th class to 10th Class: Jawahar Naovodaya Vidyalaya, Khammam District.

He passed my 10th class with **86%**(CBSE) - **Certificates Verified**

Based on his 10th percentage and entrance test conducted by a private institution, Vijayawada, he could manage to join Bipc group in my intermediate with a nominal fee of Rs 5000/-

Intermediate: Holy Cross Junior College, Vijayawada and secured **95.1%** there - ***Certificates Verified***

EAMCET

In his first attempt of 2005 Eamcet Examination, he cleared the test with **2905** rank.

With the above rank, he got a seat in Mediciti Institute of medical Sciences, Hyderabad. As it was a private institution and the fees being very high, he could not join medicine the same year.

Then Kakatiya Academy in Hyderabad, offered him a free training for an year, for Eamcet 2006. Then he reappeared Eamcet in 2006 and scored **513** rank in the state. ***Rank Card Verified***

MBBS

With the above Rank, he joined Gandhi Medical College Secunderbad (Government), in August 2006 - ***Certificates Verified***

He passed 1st year with **62%** only (which he agrees very low) since he was down for couple of months due to his father's sudden departure in Dec 2006.

Sudhir's Family's Background

His Father late Shri Kesava Rao worked for ITC Paperboards in Bhadrachalam until mid 2006 as Process Engineer, Soda Recovery Boiler. Date of joining - August 31st 1979. His reporting manager (Boss) was Mr. T R Dhar.

He resigned from that company, joined in Delta Paper Mills, Vendraa near Bhimavaram and worked for 23 days. He came to Hyderabad for House Warming Ceremony (Grihapravesam) of his newly constructed house on 16th Dec. 2006. Immediately after that he met with a fatal accident on this way back to duty. His car was taken away by the financiers (Sundaram Finance) to clear the dues. Unfortunately, He did not bear any Insurance policies to support his family behind.

His house installment is about Rs.11,000/- P.M. and Sudhir's maternal uncle is looking after it at present on the promise that they would pay as soon as they are able to.

Since his father's death, Sudhir's mother Smt K S M Lakshmi (she is from Kakinada), has been working as a teacher in a private school near the house (St Agnes School, Near Gundla Pochamapally rlyw Station, Medchal Mandal, Rangareddy Dist) in order to support her children. She earns Rs. 1500/- per month.

Conclusion

Looking at the current situation of Sudhir's family, I **strongly recommend** that he needs to be supported to continue his studies.
